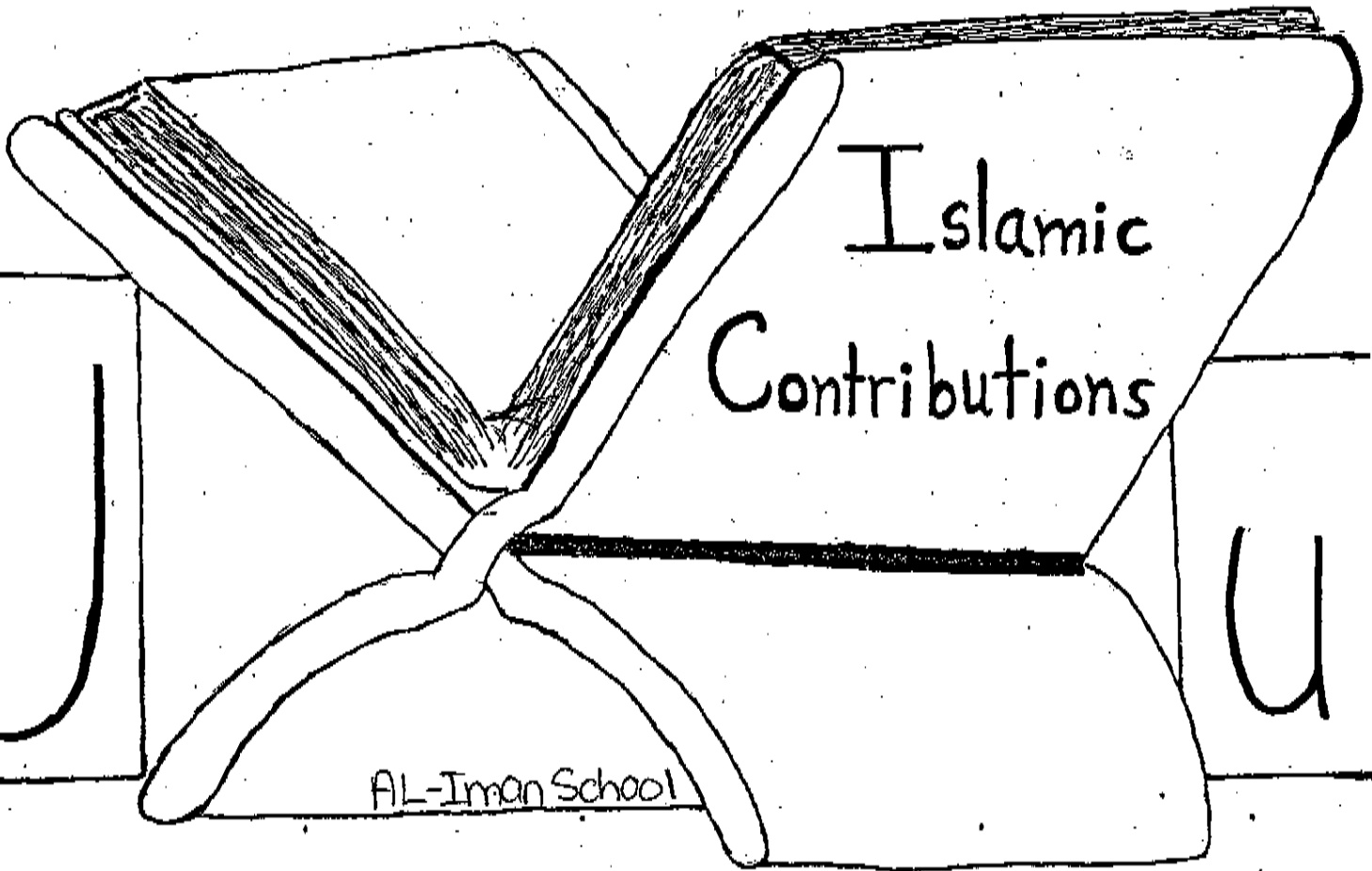
Decorated tiles, in a hundred almost fluid tints, were used to decorate mosques and palaces. (4)

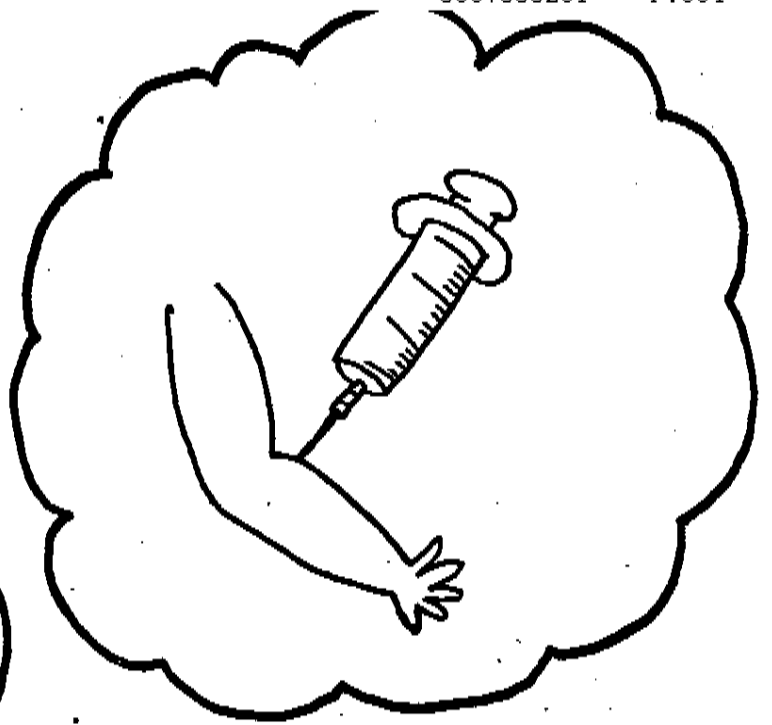
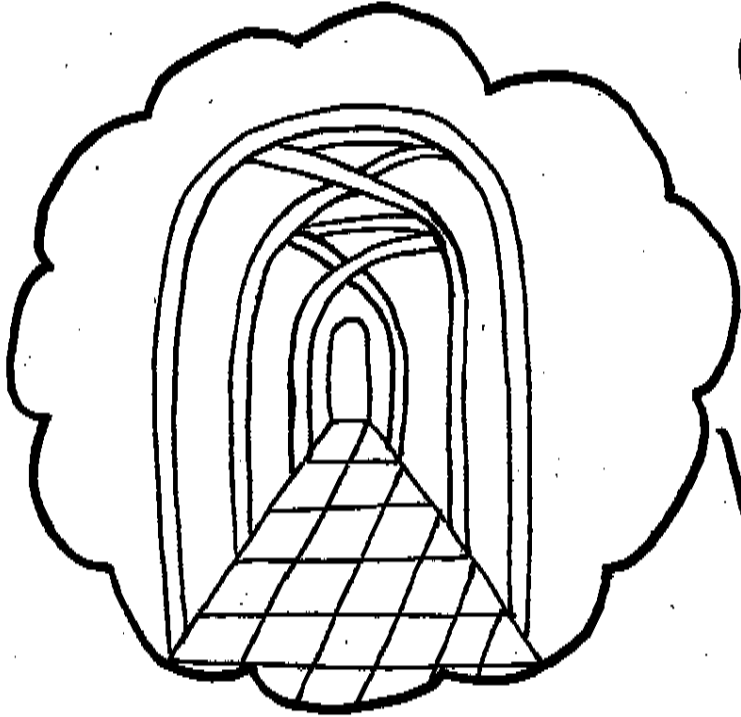

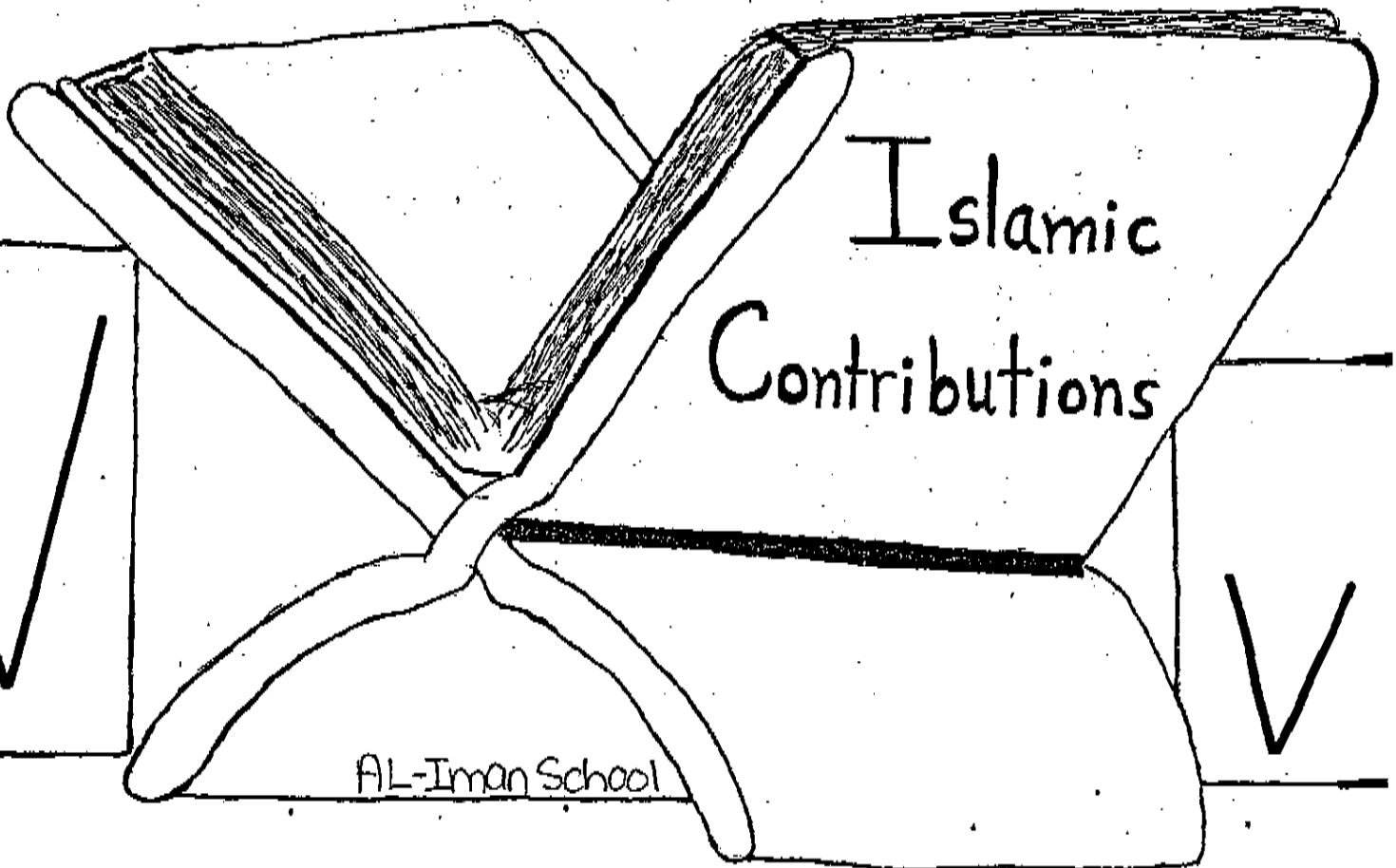


In 859 a young princess named Fatima al-Firhi founded the first degree-granting university in Fez, Morocco. It is still operating today. (5)

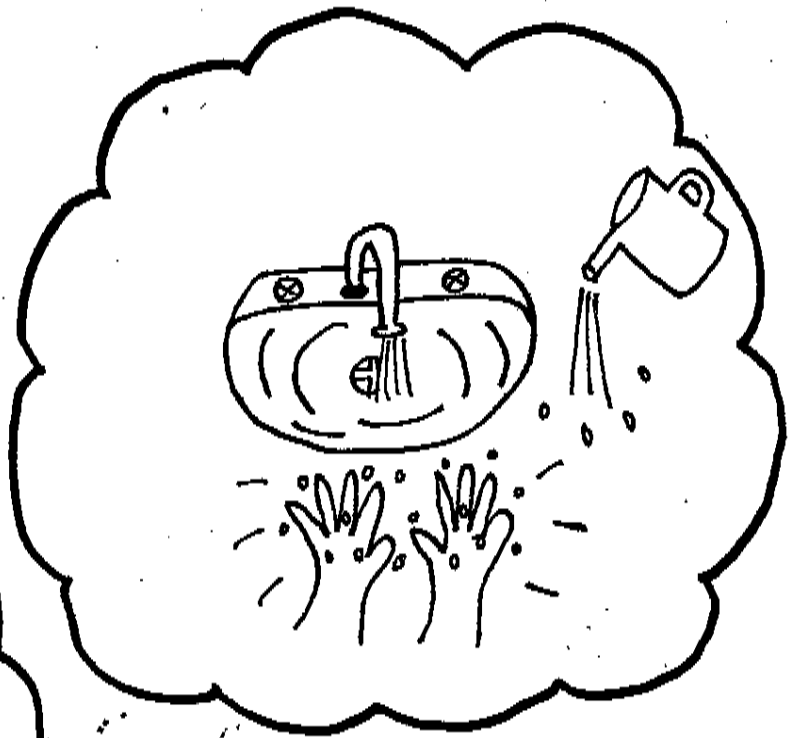
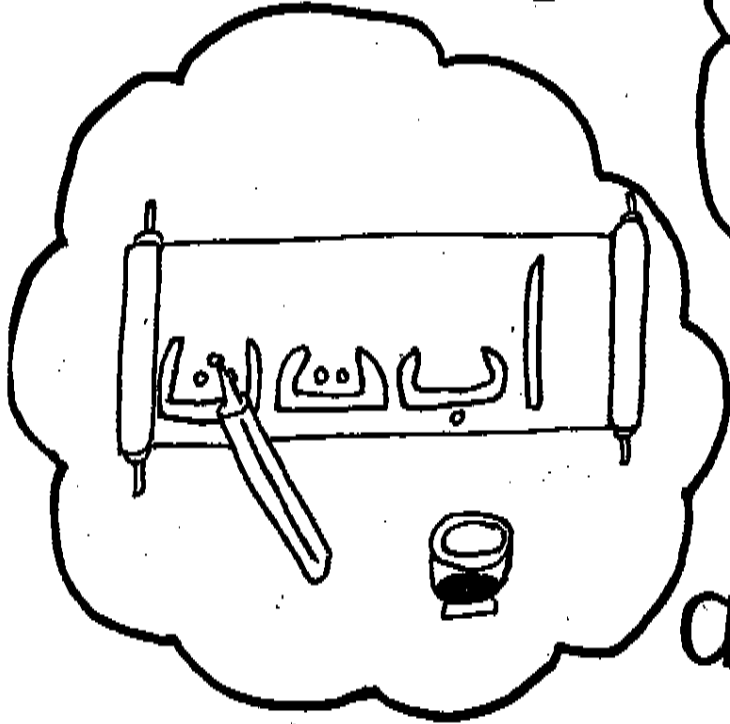

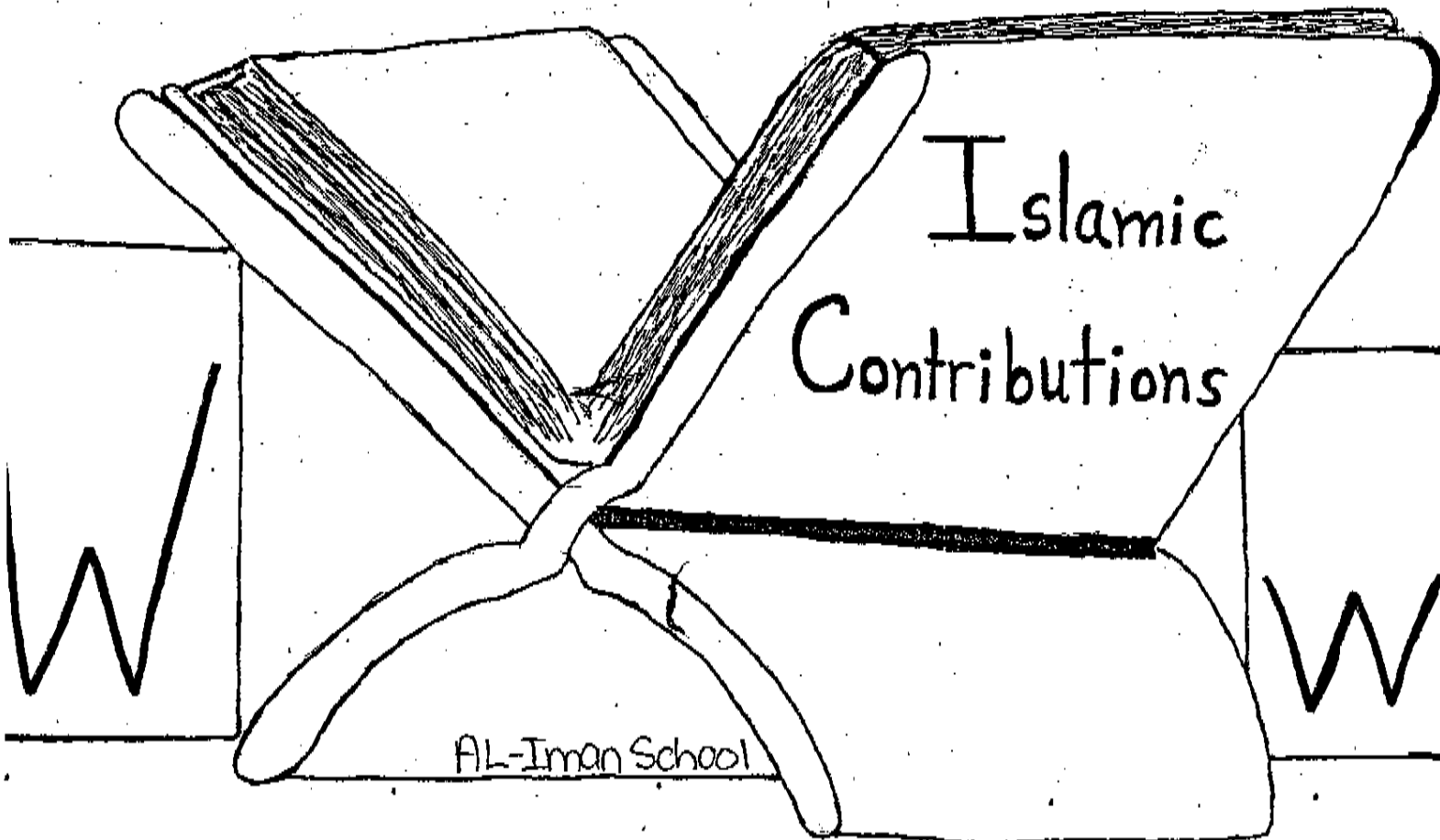
The vault, the pointed arch, seen in Europe's Gothic cathedrals was invented by Muslims. (2)
